I. Introduction

Abstract title, author(s), and affiliation(s) should be centered. Please underline the presenting author. Affiliations should be given in italic letter. Although color figures are permitted in the electronic abstract, they are printed in black-and-white in the Abstract Book.

The abstract must be submitted in .pdf file format (.doc and .tex formats are prohibited). Please don't protect the PDF file because the presentation code will be filled electronically after the submission. The electronic submission website is accessible from the Abstract page of the Congress website [2].
